JOB OPPORTUNITY:

The Vancouver Island Health Authority (Island Health) Division of Medical Imaging in Nanaimo is seeking a permanent fulltime General Radiologist with Nuclear Medicine specialty to work in Nanaimo, BC.

Opportunity to practice both Nuclear Medicine and Radiology in a collegial 10 member group. May be an opportunity to provide PET/CT services.

The position includes participation in a full call schedule giving 24 hour services. There is a small time responsibility for participation in resident teaching through the UBC Department of Radiology, and medical student teaching through the UBC Island Medical Program.

The group provides all of the imaging services for Central Island including MRI, CT, Ultrasound, X-ray, Fluoroscopy, Screening & Diagnostic Mammography, Minor Interventional Procedures and Nuclear Medicine.

Eligible candidates must hold Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada certification in both Radiology and Nuclear Medicine and be eligible for full licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC.

COMMUNITY:
